# TOUR ITINERARY

## DAY 01 Vancouver

MAR 14

Make your own way to Vancouver International Airport to check in for your flight to Arequipa via Montreal and Lima. Enjoy in-flight services.

## DAY 02 Arequipa

MAR 15

Welcome to Peru! On arrival at Lima New Jorge Chavez International Airport early this morning you will be assisted with check in at the airport hotel where you will be able to rest until your onward flight to Arequipa. On arrival at Arequipa Rodríguez Ballón International Airport the group will be met and taken on a tour of the "White City," renowned for its stunning colonial architecture and dramatic volcanic backdrop. Your tour begins at the vibrant San Camilo Market, a historic structure dating back to the late 19th century and believed to have been inspired by the designs of Gustave Eiffel. Here, you will experience the rich cultural and culinary traditions of Arequipa while discovering an array of local products and regional specialties.

Next, visit the magnificent Santa Catalina Monastery, an architectural masterpiece located in the heart of the city. Founded in the 16th century, this vast religious complex once housed women from Arequipa's most prominent families and remains one of Peru's most fascinating colonial landmarks. Continue to the scenic Carmen Alto Viewpoint, where you will have breathtaking views of the Arequipa Valley framed by the city's three iconic volcanoes, Chachani, Misti, and Pichu Picchu. Conclude your tour at the charming Yanahuara Plaza, famous for its traditional sillar stone architecture and picturesque views of the surrounding landscape. *Overnight in Arequipa.*

## DAY 03 Arequipa – Colca Canyon

MAR 16

(B/L/-)

Early this morning, journey through a spectacular landscape of snow-capped volcanoes, vast high-altitude plains, and picturesque Andean villages as we make our way to the breathtaking Colca Valley. Your first stop will be the Aguada Blanca National Reserve, a rugged wilderness known for its abundant wildlife, including guanacos, alpacas, and vicuñas roaming freely across the expansive plains. Continue through dramatic volcanic scenery, skirting the edge of the Chucura Volcano crater before reaching Patapampa's Mirador de los Andes (Andean Lookout Point). At an elevation of 16,100 feet (4,900 meters), this remarkable viewpoint offers panoramic vistas of the region's towering volcanic peaks, including Hualca Hualca, Sabancaya, and Ampato, all set against the stunning backdrop of the Andes.

The journey then continues to Chivay, gateway to the Colca Valley, where you will gain insight into the remarkable agricultural terraces and irrigation systems created centuries ago by the Collagua and Cabana civilizations. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before checking into your hotel. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure. *Overnight in Chivay.*



## **DAY 04**      **Colca Canyon** **MAR 17**      **(B/L/-)**

Early this morning, set out for the renowned Mirador de la Cruz del Cóndor (Condor Cross Viewpoint), one of the best places in the world to witness the majestic Andean Condor in flight. Perched high above the dramatic Colca Canyon, this spectacular lookout offers an unforgettable opportunity to observe these magnificent birds as they glide effortlessly on rising air currents. With a bit of luck, you may witness the awe-inspiring sight of a condor soaring gracefully against the backdrop of the vast Andean landscape. The viewpoint also provides breathtaking panoramas of the Colca Canyon, one of the deepest canyons in the world, with depths reaching over 13,650 feet (4,160 meters). The sheer scale and beauty of this natural wonder make it one of Peru's most remarkable sites.

On the return journey, visit the traditional Andean villages of Pinchollo, Maca, Achoma, and Yanque, each offering a glimpse into the region's rich cultural heritage and rural way of life. Additional highlights include the Miradores de Antahuilque, where you can admire the impressive pre-Incan agricultural terraces that continue to shape the landscape, and Choquetico, known for its fascinating hanging tombs and ancient stone-carved irrigation models. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant in Chivay. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. *Overnight in Chivay.*

## **DAY 05**      **Colca Canyon – Puno** **MAR 18**      **(B/L/-)**

After breakfast, we will embark on a scenic seven-hour journey to Puno. Along the way, we will enjoy a boxed lunch while taking in the breathtaking landscapes of the Peruvian highlands. A stop en route, will be made at Lagunillas, known for its picturesque lagoon and stunning views, before continuing on to Puno.

*Overnight in Puno.*

## **DAY 06**      **Uros and Taquile Islands (Lake Titicaca)** **MAR 19**      **(B/L/-)**

Today, enjoy an exhilarating boat excursion on Lake Titicaca, the highest navigable lake in the world. See the magnificent floating Uros Islands and Taquile Island. The floating islands of the Uros developed from totora reeds tied together and are a must-see for any traveler. The Uros people consider themselves to be the Lords of the Lake. They hunt wild birds and maintain traditional fishing methods. Taquile is a very important site, known for its archaeological remains, sacred sites, and ceremonial festivals. The island is characterized by its friendly inhabitants, who maintain the customs and traditional clothing of their ancestors. Lunch will be served in a local home. You will return to Puno later in the day. *Overnight in Puno.*



## **DAY 07** Puno – Cusco **MAR 20** (B/-/-)

Today marks one of the most extraordinary overland journeys in all South America, a sweeping passage through the soul of the Andes that is as much a feast for the senses as it is a voyage through time. The road from Puno to Cusco winds through the vast, windswept altiplano, where the air is crisp, the skies stretch endlessly, and traditional Andean villages dot the hillsides like scenes from another era. Snow-capped peaks loom in the distance as llamas and alpacas graze peacefully on the highland plains. We will stop at the ancient funerary complex of Sillustani. Perched dramatically on a peninsula above the glittering waters of Lake Umayo, this remarkable pre-Incan site is home to more than 90 Chullpas (towering cylindrical burial towers constructed by the Colla people long before the rise of the Inca Empire). Some of these extraordinary structures rise to heights of over 40 feet. Continuing onward, your journey through the highlands reveals ever-changing scenery and glimpses of rural Andean life before you arrive in Cusco. *Overnight in Cusco.*

## **DAY 08** Cusco **MAR 21** (B/-/-)

This morning we will begin exploring Cusco's remarkable archaeological sites. The first stop is Sacsayhuamán, an impressive fortress built with massive stone blocks fitted together with extraordinary precision. Then visit Qenqo, an important ceremonial and religious centre, followed by a panoramic view of Puca Pucara, the "Red Fortress." The tour continues to Tambomachay, renowned for its beautifully preserved water fountains and aqueducts. Afterward, tour the heart of the Imperial City. Strolling through the Main Square, visit the Cathedral, admired for its magnificent interiors and priceless paintings from the Cusco School of the 17th and 18th centuries. Then explore Qoricancha (the Temple of the Sun), one of the most significant structures of Incan Cusco. Dedicated to the worship of the Sun God, this sacred temple was once adorned with walls said to have been covered entirely in gold. *Overnight in Cusco.*

## **DAY 09** Cusco – Sacred Valley **MAR 22** (B/L/-)

This morning, we head to Chinchero village, famous for the extraordinary beauty and quality of its textiles before reaching the Salt Pans of Maras. A breathtaking mosaic of nearly 3,000 salt ponds cascading down the mountainside. Once vital to the Inca economy, these pools continue to yield some of the world's finest salt and remain a key livelihood for local families. This extraordinary site, with its gleaming white terraces set against the Andes, offers incredible photo opportunities. A lunch stop will be made at local restaurant before a stop at one of the last remaining Incan towns, Ollantaytambo, which was once fiercely guarded by a massive fortress. Discover the large archaeological complex of what used to serve as a wayside inn for royal delegations on long journeys.

## **DAY 10** Sacred Valley – **MAR 23** Machu Picchu – Cusco (B/L/-)

This morning travel on an Expedition train through the Sacred Valley to Aguas Calientes, where you will board a shuttle up to Machu Picchu, the "Lost City of the Incas". Perched 8,200 feet above the valley, the city of Machu Picchu was hidden by mountains and semi-tropical jungles for 400 years until it was discovered by Hiram Bingham in 1911. Learn about the history of this magical place. In the afternoon take the train back to Ollantaytambo Rail Station, where you will be met and transferred to your hotel in Cusco. *Overnight in Cusco.*

## **DAY 11** Cusco – Lima

### **MAR 24** (B/-/-)

After a leisurely breakfast you will be transferred to the Cusco Alejandro Velasco Astete International Airport to check in for a flight to Lima. Upon arrival at Lima New Jorge Chavez International Airport where you will be met and transferred to your hotel for check in. Enjoy your afternoon at leisure. *Overnight in Lima.*

**\* Optional: An Evening at the Larco Museum with Dinner inc.**

**Return transfers: CAD 250 per person (min 4 pax)**

This evening you will be transferred to the Larco Museum to explore the museum's exhibits; there are over 50,000 ancient Peruvian pots; along with glittering jewellery and intricate masks; marvel at the detail of Moche portrait vessels, ceramic sculptures resembling human faces; and discover ceramics created by ancient Inca, Nazca, and Chancay cultures. Afterwards take a seat in the elegant dining room to begin your epicurean experience. Enjoy the beautifully sculpted gardens as you sip a freshly mixed pisco sour. Taste regional specialties such as lomo saltado, tender strips of beef cooked with vegetables and spices, accompanied by creamy causa limena, a mashed potato dish flavoured with chili and lime.

## **DAY 12** Lima

### **MAR 25** (B/-/-)

This morning, enjoy a tour of Lima. The first stop will be in the Main Square, to explore on foot and admire the exteriors of the Government Palace, the Cathedral, and the City Hall, examples of Lima's, still-present colonial architectural opulence. Visit the Cathedral; walking through its numerous chapels, discover various architectural styles and learn about the religious history of Peru. We will continue with a visit to San Francisco Convent built in the 17th century, and its catacombs, an ancient underground cemetery. Then journey through the streets of modern Lima to San Isidro, the heart of the city's financial district; and Miraflores, a perfect spot to enjoy wonderful views of the Pacific Ocean. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. *Overnight in Lima.*

## **DAY 13** Lima – Vancouver

### **MAR 26** (B/-/-)

This morning you will be transferred back to Lima New Jorge Chavez International Airport to check in for your homeward flight. *End of Services.*

### DAY 01 Lima – Iquitos MAR 26 By Flight (-/-/D)

This morning you will be transferred to Lima New Jorge Chavez International Airport to check in for a flight to Iquitos. Upon our arrival in Iquitos, you will be met and taken on a short city tour on the way to the Explorama jetty. Travel by boat along the Amazon River, covering 40 kilometres downriver to your lodge located in the Amazon Jungle. This afternoon, enjoy a walk in the beautiful surrounding primary forest, filled with trees such as the giant ceiba, which inspired the name of the lodge. After dinner there will be an opportunity to listen to local guitar and flute music in the “El Tucán” bar or perhaps take a night walk to observe caimans and other nocturnal animals. *Overnight in the Amazon.*

### DAY 02 Iquitos MAR 27 (B/L/D)

If you are an early riser there will be an opportunity to do some birdwatching. After breakfast, visit a small village of Yaguas indigenous people, where the guide will offer his insights into the local culture. There'll be time to enjoy the community's handcrafts, as well as to see how the blowpipe is still used by some Yaguas people for hunting. In the afternoon, visit the riverside community of Indiana, and weather-permitting we may be fortunate enough to enjoy a spectacular sunset over the Amazon River. *Overnight in the Amazon.*

### DAY 03 Iquitos MAR 28 (B/L/D)

Set off early this morning for ExplorNapó Lodge, arriving in time for breakfast. From the lodge, enjoy a wonderful canopy walk (approx. 500 meters long, high up in the forest canopy, the tallest platform of which rises 35 meters above the ground). After lunch, walk to the “ReNuPeRu” Ethnobotanical Garden, where the guide will introduce one to the more than 240 species of the Amazon's medicinal plants cultivated by a shaman, who will explain their uses. Afterwards return to Ceiba Tops where you will have time to enjoy the lodge's facilities. *Overnight in the Amazon.*

### DAY 04 Iquitos – Lima – Vancouver MAR 29 (B/-/-)

Time permitting, you may have the opportunity to participate in a hike or a boat tour visiting the surrounding area before being transferred back to Iquitos Coronel FAP Francisco Secada Vignetta International Airport to check in for your flight to Lima and onwards to Vancouver. *End of Services.*
